(April 7, 2023; Calabasas, CA) Harbor Freight Tools is adding a powerful 20V Brushless Cordless High-Torque ½ in. Impact Wrench with Friction Ring to its popular BAUER™ line.

The Brushless Cordless High-Torque ½ in. Impact Wrench has a high-performance brushless motor that delivers up to 1000 ft.-lbs. of bolt breakaway torque and up to 650 ft.-lbs. of fastening torque for loosening or tightening hex-head bolts, lug nuts, and fasteners.

Providing more torque, control, runtime, and durability than traditional brushed motors, the Cordless High-Torque ½ in. Impact Wrench has a three-speed motor that operates at 0-700, 0-1400, and 0-1800 RPM. It also features a variable speed trigger for added precision and control.

The friction ring ensures secure socket retention by keeping the socket seated on the ½ in. square anvil drive. The all-metal gear construction adds extra durability, while a textured, ergonomically-designed overmold provides a secure grip and comfort.

For working in dimly-lit areas, the Impact Wrench features a bright LED light to illuminate the workspace.

Currently priced at \$129.99, the BAUER 20V Brushless Cordless High-Torque Impact Wrench with Friction Ring is available only at Harbor Freight. The 20V battery system is compatible with over 70 products within the BAUER 20V lineup. Battery and charger are sold separately.
